Year 3 Curriculum Newsletter

Dear Parent / Carer

Welcome back to the second half of the Autumn Term! Our theme for this term is 'Brazil' We will be linking our learning across the curriculum so that the children really get the sense of the geography, artwork and culture within the country, with a focus on rainforests.

Subject Overviews

<u>English</u>

This half term we will be writing poems and non-chronological reports about the rainforest. We will also be working on grammar, reading skills, spelling and handwriting which includes getting used to writing in pen.

<u>Maths</u>

This half term we will be moving on to the written methods of multiplication and division. We will also be helping the children to develop their problem solving skills and their ability to link mathematical learning. Once children have reached our early target times tables of 2x, 5x, and 10x we will move onto 3x and 4x later in the term.

Science


In the second half of this term, we will have the chance to learn about magnets and forces where we will investigate how strong different magnets are and classify materials based on their levels of magnetism.

Computing

In computing we will then link with our English topic to create a fact file on animals of the rainforest and learn how to copy and paste images and use them to best effect with text.

Topic (Geography)

In geography we will learn how to use an atlas and different maps to locate topographical features, biomes, vegetation belts and cities. We will also learn about the human and physical geography of a region and investigate how its land use has changed.

<u>Art</u>

After half term we start our art studies by looking at the work of Frida Khalo before creating our own painted collages based on her techniques.

RE

This year all of our RE will be about Christianity under the themes of Believing, Belonging and Behaving.

PE & Games

In PE on Tuesday mornings, the children will be developing their dance skills. In Wednesday games lessons, they will develop their collaboration and communication skills, as well as their ball skills playing netball and basketball and focus on coordination and control in hockey.

PE Kit Reminder: Children are to come to school wearing their PE kits on Tuesday and Wednesday please.

<u>Music</u>

In this half of the term, the children will link their learning about the rainforests in Brazil to music by composing soundscapes using body percussion. They will also start looking at using the djembe drums.

<u>French</u>

The children will be exploring the language and developing their confidence through an interactive story called 'Milo's adventures in the rainforest' which links to our topic.

<u>Homework</u>

Reading

We ask that children read each day for 10 minutes. Each child in Year 3 will be issued with a level appropriate reading book within the first two weeks. It really helps their progress if they are heard regularly at home and we would be grateful if you could initial their Personal Log each time you hear them. You can also access books online through Oxford Owl.

<u>Maths</u>

To support the times tables check (MTC) which happens nationally in Year 4, the children will be given time in school to practise their times tables and will be tested regularly. They can also practise online using TT Rock Stars where they can earn certificates for practising the most or being the most improved student.

Spellings

The children will be set a new spelling list to learn once a week on a Friday. We find that practising for a few minutes every day really helps the children to learn and remember their spelling patterns and rules. Children can practise in their books or online using EdShed where they can play games, earn points and maybe a certificate.

<u>Topic</u>

We also set a homework project per topic which enables the children to further explore their learning. The children are encouraged to complete this homework and we share all of the projects with the whole year group.

Children are encouraged to complete their homework because it reinforces the learning which takes place in school and is another opportunity to practise the skills they have learned. Those who complete their homework regularly and to a good standard will earn rewards.
